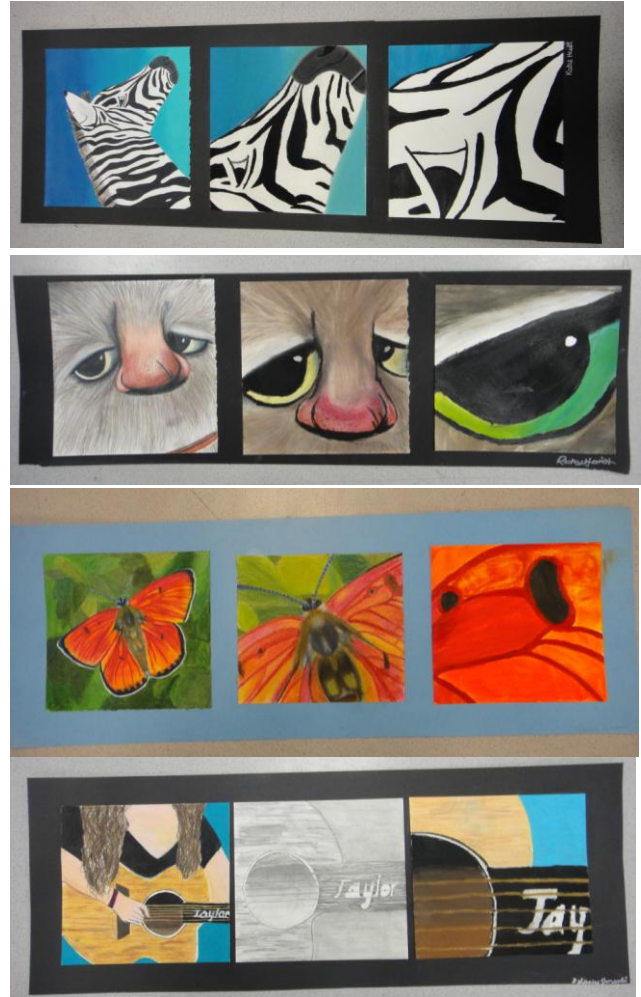
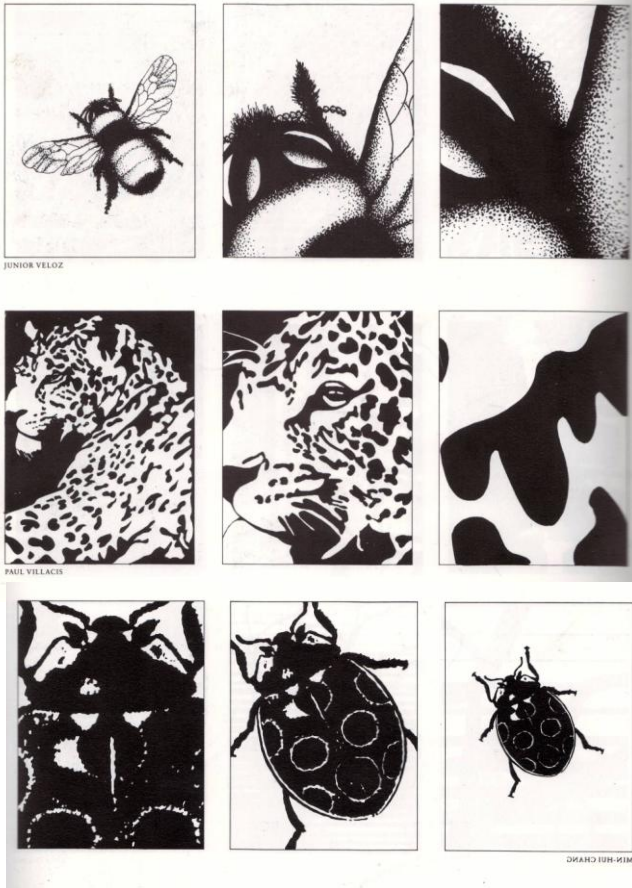


Gr. 9 Art RST – LESS IS MORE

You are going to choose **one picture/object/cartoon** and reproduce **three different views** of it with **three different mediums**. Here are some examples – see how you zoom in a bit more each time:



Follow these steps for great success!

Step 1: Find a **picture/object/cartoon** that you really like – you will be working on it for a number of days!

Step 2: Decide what **mediums** you will be using. Consider that you will be given 3 mediums sized panels of thick paper and that you will need to have good balance on each. Therefore, there will be a lot of space to cover, on all 3 of them, and that the most zoomed in one will need to be very detailed. Choose your mediums accordingly. Your choices are any of the mediums we have learned this year:
