

NARRATIVE PAINTING!

We are going to use acrylic paint to creative a narrative painting. What is a narrative painting, you ask? It is combining images and words to tell a story. We are going to use CD covers and songs from the CD to create our narrative paintings.

- Step 1:** Choose a CD – it is important that you like one or more images from the CD jacket and one or more of the songs on the CD.
- Step 2:** Print out a copy of the CD jacket (or bring one in if you own it). Also bring in the lyrics to one or more of the songs on the CD.
- Step 3:** Using the boxes below (thumbnail sketches) plan how your painting will look. Your painting will have one or more of the images from the CD jacket in the foreground and the words in the background. You will either paint/write the words on the canvas, or you will cut them up and use special technique to attach them to the canvas. **Remember**, it is important to do at LEAST 3 thumbnail sketches to work out the best layout! (plus it is part of your mark☺)
